

## School Student Travel



#### School student travel information for parents and students

#### School Travel Passes

Applications are now open for 2025 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) travel.

Students in the Opal network applying for an Opal card (including a Term Bus Pass) for the first time will receive their School Opal card at their nominated postal address from mid-January 2025.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass but have not yet applied need to apply or update their details as soon as possible.

In the Opal network, students should travel with a Child/Youth Opal card until they receive their valid School Opal card. If outside Greater Sydney, parents should contact their local bus operator to discuss their travel needs.

Students living in rural and regional areas will receive their travel pass from their nominated transport operator. It may be issued via their school or be sent directly to them at home. Note: some rural and regional operators do not issue travel passes. Students/parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

#### Terms of Use

Students using School Opal cards must tap on and tap off in line with the Opal terms of use.

This includes travel within the approved times between 6.30am and 7.00pm from Monday to Friday on school days only. Students must use their Child/Youth Opal card for any travel outside these times.

All students are required to comply with the **Student code of conduct**. The code of conduct aims to ensure the safety and well-being of school children and other passengers. It is important that parents ensure their child is aware of this, as failure to comply with the code of conduct can result in a suspension from travel.

## SCHOOL ZONE RULES AND PENALTIES

### Choose safety over convenience.

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	NO STOPPING What does it mean? You cannot stop for any reason (including queuing or waiting for a space). Why is it there? To keep sight lines clear for drivers and children so both have more time to avoid accidents.	Fine: \$410 Demerit points: 2
	NO PARKING What does it mean? You may only park for two minutes to drop off or pick up children, and you have to stay withing 3m of your vehicle. If no spaces are available, drive around the block and only return when there is a space. Why is it there? To provide a safe place for children to be set down and picked up without endangering others.	Fine: \$227 Demerit points: 2
	BUS ZONE What does it mean? You must not stop your vehicle in the bus zone for any reason (including queuing and waiting for a space) unless you are driving a public bus. Why is it there? To provide a safe place for large buses to set down and pick up school children.	Fine: \$410 Demerit points: 2
	PEDESTRIAN CROSSING What does it mean? Keep an area of 20m before and 10m after a pedestrian crossing clear. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian crossing. Why is it there? To ensure children can be clearly seen by vehicles approaching the crossing.	Fine: \$544 Demerit points: 2
	DOUBLE PARKING What does it mean? You must not stop your vehicle, and or park in the middle of the road to drop off and pick up. Why is it there? Double parking forces cars to go around you causing traffic congestion. It also reduces the view of drivers and children crossing the road.	Fine: \$410 Demerit points: 2
- 2 +	DRIVEWAYS AND FOOTPATHS What does it mean? Do not park your vehicle on or across a driveway. Why is it there? To ensure that you don't force pedestrians onto the road to get around you.	Fine: \$410 Demerit points: 2
