
Timeline for 2024

6 March - Digital Expression of Interest (EOI) forms will be available via the Petersham Public School website

(https://petersham-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/about-our-school/enrolment.html)

- 3 April Digital EOI form must be completed before this date
- 9 May Selective High School Placement Test (only for those who applied in 2023)
- 13 May High schools commence Round 1 offers for Choice 1 non-local applications
- 11 June High schools commence Round 2 offers for Choice 2 non-local applications
- 30 July High schools commence Round 3 offers for Choice 3 non-local applications
- 4 September All offers have been made for Year 7 placement using the Online Enrolment System
- 3 December designated High School Orientation Day (some schools may differ or have additional sessions)






